Hartwell House is a magnificent stately home of great importance in a glorious setting, yet only two miles from the busy market town of Aylesbury and 20 miles from Oxford. London is easily reached by train or car in about an hour and Heathrow Airport is just 35 miles away. There is a direct motorway link with the Midlands. Situated in 90 acres of parkland, landscaped by a contemporary of 'Capability' Brown, Hartwell House provides a delightful country house setting which will add lustre to every meeting and social occasion. The hotel, which has 46 bedrooms and suites, has won many awards for the quality

and excellence of its food, outstanding hospitality, and has been host to many International meetings, Heads of State, and important events such as the 2013 meeting of G7 Finance Ministers.

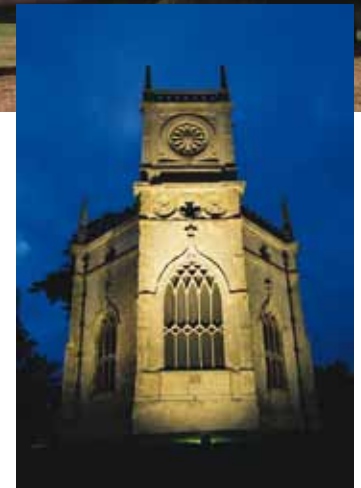
This impressive house, which has both Jacobean and Georgian facades, has been skilfully and sympathetically restored by Historic House Hotels, which has extended the restoration to include the 18th century stables, coach houses and indoor riding school to create bedrooms and suites in Hartwell Court, purpose built meeting rooms known as the Hartwell Rooms and the Hartwell Spa with an indoor swimming pool and gymnasium.

Waddesdon Manor

This Renaissance-style château was built by Baron Ferdinand de Rothschild to display his outstanding collection of art treasures and to entertain the fashionable world. The 45 rooms on view combine the highest quality French furniture and decorative arts from the 18th century with superb English portraits and Dutch Old Masters. The Victorian garden is considered one of the finest in Britain with its parterre, seasonal displays, fountains and statuary. At its heart lies the aviary, stocked with species once part of Baron Ferdinand's collection. Visit the new contemporary art gallery in the Coach House at the Stables. Note: managed by a Rothschild family charitable trust. House entrance by timed tickets only.

Bodysgallen Hall

Standing in over 200 acres of its own parkland to the south of Llandudno with spectacular views of Snowdonia and Conwy Castle. Believed to have 13th century origins, Bodysgallen Hall provides all that is best in country house hospitality. Beautiful gardens include a rare 17th century parterre of box hedges filled with sweet-scented herbs, a rockery with a cascade, a walled rose garden, and several follies. The hotel has two restaurants, with imaginative food, which have been awarded three rosettes by the AA with fine-dining in the Main Hall, prepared from fresh local produce and complemented by fine wine. 1620, Bodysgallen Hall's Bistro offers simpler good value food in a contemporary setting.

Middlethorpe Hall

Middlethorpe Hall is a William and Mary country house, built in 1699 of mellow red brick with limestone dressings. The restoration, conservation and conversion into a country house hotel have been carried out to exacting and historically accurate standards. It has been elegantly decorated in period and furnished with antiques and fine paintings, so that its look and ambiance is that of a well-kept, well-furnished private country house. Middlethorpe Hall is renowned for its imaginative cuisine and its panelled dining rooms which overlook the manicured gardens. It also boasts a Health and Fitness Spa built behind the façade of two listed Edwardian cottages.
