

The company was established in 1979 with the intention of providing a secure new use for country houses at risk, ultimately to become the property of The National Trust.

Throughout 2018, also of course a Royal Wedding year, we will again host an interesting programme of garden tours, wine evenings, dining and spa offers, and other cultural events for your delight. You will always be certain of a traditional welcome when you return to historic Hartwell House.


