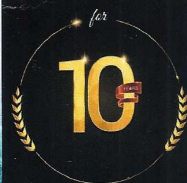

## The National Museum of Computing at Bletchley Park, Bletchley

If you're planning an event or product launch, especially one linked to technology and innovation or cyber security, there's nowhere better to hold it than at The National Museum of Computing, home to the world-famous WWII Code Breakers. Set in the grounds of Bletchley Park, it's an Aladdin's cave of electronics, housing the world's largest working collection of historic computers, including the world's first electronic computer, the rebuilt Colossus, and the oldest working digital computer, the WITCH. They also have some original space invaders machines, in working order! There's space for up to 40 people seated theatre style inside the museum, which also hosts regular lectures, festivals and demonstrations; or for more guests, we can set up a large marquee in the extensive grounds.

### Hartwell House

An impressive Grade I listed country house, located in the Vale of Aylesbury that dates back 1,000 years. The house and its surrounding 90 acres of landscape gardens are now owned by the National Trust and operate as a hotel, fine dining restaurant and spa. VIP guests would be in good company as the hotel has accommodated many Heads of State and hosted the meeting of G7 Finance Ministers in 2013.



### Stoke Park Country Club

With 300 acres of beautiful parkland, this five-star luxury hotel features boutique bedrooms, an award-winning restaurant, a world-renowned 27 hole championship golf course and sumptuous spa, just two miles from the M4.

### Cliveden House

On Buckinghamshire's border with Berkshire, this luxurious hotel and spa in an Italianate mansion dates back to 1666. The Beatles stayed here at the height of their fame and the most luxurious rooms feature fireplaces and hot tubs. There's also a private cottage on the banks of the Thames.

### Danesfield House

A turn of the century country house hotel and Spa situated between Marlow and Henley-on-Thames. The 79 individually designed rooms are surrounded by 65 acres of parkland with an Italian water garden, a tennis court and a croquet lawn.

### Stoke Place

A four star 17th century country house hotel offering 39 luxury rooms, most with Edwardian free-standing baths and king sized hypnos beds.
